Viva 2 Module 1: Mis vacaciones – My Holidays

Lesson Sequence:

- 1. Say what you did on holiday
- 2. Use the past tense with regular verbs
- 3. Talk about the weather during the holiday
- 4. Give opinions about holidays
- 5. Describe a past holiday experience

Key Vocabulary:

fui, visité, descansé, tomé el sol, comí paella, hizo calor/frío, me gustó, fue divertido/aburrido/interesante

Key Knowledge:

Use of the preterite tense with regular verbs; time expressions; giving past opinions.

Common Misconceptions:

Mixing present and past tenses; incorrect endings in the preterite; confusing 'fui' and 'fue'.

Key Questions:

- ¿Adónde fuiste de vacaciones?
- ¿Qué hiciste?
- ¿Qué tal fue?



Viva 2 Module 2: Todo sobre mi vida – All About My Life

Lesson Sequence:

- 1. Talk about free-time activities
- 2. Use present tense verbs to describe routines
- 3. Talk about what you like to do using 'me gusta'
- 4. Talk about what you do with your phone
- 5. Discuss your daily routine and media use

Key Vocabulary:

escucho música, veo la tele, juego con mi consola, me gusta, me encanta, uso mi móvil para..., chatear, mandar mensajes

Key Knowledge:

Use of present tense regular verbs; infinitives after 'me gusta'; technology and media vocabulary.

Common Misconceptions:

Using conjugated verbs after 'me gusta'; forgetting present tense endings; confusing 'ver' and 'mirar'.

Key Questions:

- ¿Qué haces en tu tiempo libre?
- ¿Te gusta usar tu móvil? ¿Para qué?
- ¿Qué tipo de música/programas te gustan?



Viva 2 Module 3: ¡A comer! – Let's Eat!

Lesson Sequence:

- 1. Talk about meals and mealtimes
- 2. Say what you like/don't like to eat
- 3. Describe what you normally eat using present tense
- 4. Order food in a restaurant
- 5. Talk about a special meal using past tense

Key Vocabulary:

desayuno, como, ceno, me gusta(n), no me gusta(n), suelo comer, quiero..., de primero/segundo/postre, fue delicioso

Key Knowledge:

Use of 'soler' + infinitive; food vocabulary; using present and past tenses to describe meals.

Common Misconceptions:

Incorrect use of plural with 'gustar'; forgetting stem changes in verbs like 'querer' or 'preferir'; confusing present and past tense.

Key Questions:

- ¿Qué sueles comer?
- ¿Qué comiste ayer?
- ¿En qué puedo servir?
